WHY

Sometimes it's about a little help with daily tasks around the home...

Sometimes just a little help is needed when a loved one is recovering from illness or surgery...

FLEXIBILITY

What if you only need Personal Care Services for a short period? By working with our Personal Care Supervisor, care plans will be developed in order to meet your needs.

If you or anyone you know need this service, call the Community Action Agency Personal Care Supervisor just to chat about the service or to schedule an in-home visit ... at no cost.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Your Personal Care provider can help with various tasks, like...

- Caregiver Respite
- Bathing
- Dressing
- Hair Care
- Meals
- Walking
- Medicine Reminders
- Light Housekeeping
- Range of Motion

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED

Personal Care providers cannot provide nursing care (such as wound care, administer injections, provide foot care, or be responsible for follow-up medical orders from the hospital or physician).

WHAT'S THE COST

When applying for our program, our personal care supervisor will let you know if grant funds are available at the time of your assessment.

Personal Care Services are also available at reasonable hourly rates. The Personal Care supervisor will be happy to review these fees with you and your family in order to explore all your options, such as private pay or insurance.

You may also be eligible for Medicaid waiver or VA Benefits -- which will reduce your out-of-pocket expenses.

Service availability is contingent on staffing.
