The "Walk for Warmth" fund-raiser to help Schoolcraft County residents who must deal with heating emergencies is scheduled for 9 a.m. Saturday, February 24, 2018, at the Manistique Senior Center, 101 Main Street. Registration will take place from 8-9 a.m. with the short symbolic walk to follow at 9 a.m.

For those who may not care to walk, there is also a continental breakfast being served from 8-9 a.m. with free will offerings being accepted.

Support can be given in any of the following ways:

- ▶ Donating money
- ▶ Coming for breakfast and making a donation
- ▶ Soliciting pledges and turning them in the day of the walk (pledge sheet enclosed)
- ▶ Walking on February 24 by yourself or as part of a group (organizations & churches are encouraged to carry their banners)
- ▶ Encourage others to participate by promoting the walk in your church's or organization's bulletin or newsletter
- ▶ Taking up a group collection

Every dollar raised in Schoolcraft County is used to provide heat assistance to Schoolcraft County residents. The Community Action Agency walk is cosponsored by Kewadin Cares, Radio Results Network, Schoolcraft Memorial Hospital and WJMN-Local TV3.

Since 2012, \$35,173 has been raised by the Schoolcraft County Walk for Warmth, assisting 148 households in Schoolcraft County
