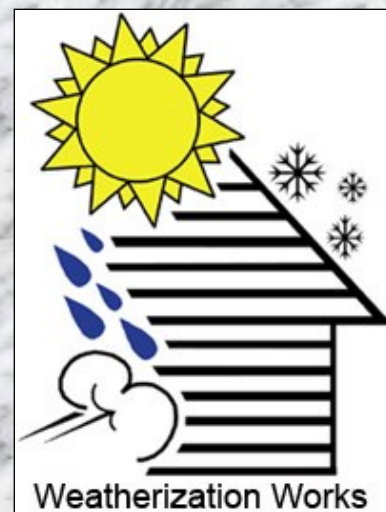


WEATHERIZATION SERVICES AND ENERGY ASSISTANCE

The Menominee-Delta-Schoolcraft Community Action Agency is a leading provider of Weatherization Services and Energy Assistance for income-eligible households in the Central Upper Peninsula counties of Menominee, Delta, Schoolcraft and Marquette/Alger. Through the federal Weatherization Assistance Program and through their partnerships with many of the state's utility companies, CAAs have resources to help qualified households reduce their energy use and lower their utility bills. A properly weatherized, energy efficient home can save households hundreds of dollars a year! All services to qualified applicants are free and may include some or all of the following measures:

- Home energy audits
- Wall and attic insulation and ventilation
- Refrigerator replacement
- Water heater replacement
- Programmable Thermostats
- Window and door repair/replacement
- Other energy saving products and services

MDSCAA also may be able to help income-eligible households with utility bills through a variety of funding sources, including the federal Low Income Heating Emergency Assistance Program (LIHEAP), the Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP), and the CAA Walk for Warmth fund-raiser.
