

HOMESTEAD/HOME HEATING TAX APPOINTMENTS: Tax assistance season is upon us. We are now taking appointments for Homestead and Home Heating Credit tax credits. April 15 is not the ending date to file for these individual credits, so please do not panic. Please get your paperwork together though while waiting for your appointment. What you need:

Proof of income for 2024. This includes your Social Security-1099 statement, and any other 1099 tax statements from 2024 from pensions, annuities and other income. We need to know your total gross and net income in 2024. If you are filing for a Homestead Tax Credit, we will need your tax information for 2024 including your taxable value of your homestead, and what you paid for taxed. For your Home Heating Credit, we need what you paid for heating costs from 11/1/23 through 10/31/24.

We can deduct things like your insurance premium costs for healthcare, including Medicare premiums, and your PIP premiums on your car insurance. If you would rather drop your tax information off, and have us call you when it is done, you can do that too. If you have questions, or need an appointment, please call the center.

#### Medicare Minutes

By Renelle Betters MMAP Counselor CAA/Menominee Sr. Center

MMAP counselors can assist you with a variety of Medicare or Medicaid issues. Some examples are:

\*Explain insurance coverage in simple terms. \*Assist with appeals when there are issues with billing or claims.

\*Help apply for assistance for Medicaid or low-income subsidy programs.

\*Help finding patient assistance programs.

MMAP Counselors are located at most of our Senior Centers in the U.P. and lower Michigan.

#### MEDICARE ADVANTAGE OPEN ENROLLMENT PERIOD: JANUARY 1-MARCH 31, 2025

In this timeframe, if you are enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan, you are eligible to look at and compare other Medicare Advantage plans, and find a different one of the same level (meaning including a drug plan etc.) to change. You could also drop your Medicare Advantage plan, and return to original Medicare and pick up a stand-alone drug plan. Each decision should be reviewed carefully

so that you understand your coverage. For example: If you are looking to return to original Medicare, pick up a stand-alone drug plan, and pick up a Medigap supplemental insurance plan,

know that outside of your initial enrollment window, or new to Medicare Advantage window, the Medigap insurance companies will ask health questions, and depending on your health status could deny you coverage. It may also take a little time for an agent to get back to you, so don't wait until the last minute.

So, before you change totally, do your research, or make an appointment with a MMAP counselor to help you understand changes you may want to make to your Medicare coverage.



TAX TIME IS HERE!! Most seniors qualify for 2 tax credits offered by the State of Michigan. They are the Homestead Property Tax Credit and the Home Heating Tax Credit. Certain documents are needed to file these credits. These include:  $\Rightarrow$  1099 Social Security statement for 2024  $\Rightarrow$  Interest and dividend income for 2024  $\Rightarrow$  Retirement pension, annuity & IRA benefits for 2024  $\Rightarrow$  SSI benefits for 2024  $\Rightarrow$  Summer & winter property tax statements for 2024 OR rental receipts  $\Rightarrow$  A printout from your fuel provider showing how much you were billed for fuel from <u>November 1, 2023 through October 31, 2024</u> If you have a supplemental health insurance policy besides Medicare, include proof showing how much you paid for that policy in 2024. Dental, vision & prescription drug premiums may also be claimed. Not all of these documents may pertain to you. Call the center for an appointment. <u>As a reminder, I do not prepare federal or</u> state tax returns.


