Christie Uecke has been our Menominee Senior Center Aide since April of 2023.


If you recognize her, she handles our take out meals. Folks love to see her as she is always bubbly and sincere.


Christie says her job is rewarding as she gets to see seniors and joke with them, and also because she works with a great staff.



Medicare Minutes

MMAP counselors can assist you with a variety of Medicare or Medicaid issues. Some examples are:

*Explain insurance coverage in simple terms. *Assist with appeals when there are issues with billing or claims. *Help apply for assistance for Medicaid or

low-income subsidy programs. *Help finding patient assistance programs.

MMAP Counselors are located at most of our Senior Centers in the U.P. and lower Michigan.

MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT SEASON:

The Medicare annual Open Enrollment season is upon us! From October 15th through December 7th, this period is for folks looking to compare drug plans, and Medicare Advantage plans and make changes for 2025. The changes that you make during this period will take effect on January 1, 2025. *Why look into it?* Well, each year drug plans can make

changes to their formularies, prices, preferred pharmacies etc. even change hands-thus discontinuing their plans. So, pay attention to any mailings you receive from your current health and drug plans. Medicare Advantage plans may change their drug coverage, and also health care coverage prices. They can also add little bonus features that are not included in regular Medicare that may be worth looking into. We give you the information to

make an informed decision for yourself. We will be taking appointments starting in late October into November to help folks with their comparisons. If you wish to make an appointment, call our center. In certain cases, we can do a quick review over the phone too to see if it will warrant an in-person appointment.

What we will need to help you: Your Medicare cards for your health and or drug plans. We will also need a most recent list of your medications to compare for 2025. If you have created a Medicare.gov account on your own already, you can bring in your username and password and we can help you through that portal. This is free & independent Medicare counseling from MMAP certified counselors.
