The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

TEFAP Eligibility

1. At each distribution you will be required to provide your name, full address, household size and how you are eligible.
2. Eligibility TEFAP participants must fall at or under 200% of the federal poverty income guidelines. See the chart below.
3. Current participants of SNAP, WIC, CSFP, FPDIR, SSI automatically qualify for TEFAP.
4. All TEFAP information collection is self-declared. Eligibility must be self-declared at each distribution—either in writing or verbally.
